### What sort of men are you looking for?

We include a range of men. 'Perfection' is not required. You must be 18 years or over. We are *particularly* keen to hear from you if you feel you're in any of the following categories:

- Non-white
- In possession of chest/body hair
- 'Typically masculine'
- Aged 30+
- Willing to do explicit shots.

If you don't fit into any of these categories, we still want to hear from you.

Me and my lady friend/gentleman friend want to do a couple shoot – are you up for that? Potentially, yes!

# I'd like to do a shoot, but I'm worried that appearing this way might affect my career.

You don't have to use your real name, age or location in association with your shoot, which can provide you with an extra level of security against being identified. However, we don't publish shots that are 'anonymised', ie, in which the model's face can't be seen.

Agreeing to do a shoot does not mean agreeing to have your image published in Filament; you'll always be given a chance to veto images you don't like. You can pull out at any point up until you sign our image use agreement.

In short, we can't say you won't have any issues with your career as a result of appearing in Filament, but we are not aware that any of our models – whose careers have ranged from nursery teaching to finance – have had any such issues to date.

### What sort of shots should I send?

Email us up to six low-resolution (eg, 72DPI at A6 size) colour images that clearly show your face and body. If you are interested in doing fully nude modelling, a fully nude shot would help. Body or body part shots (your cock or burn, for example) without a face shot are of no interest to us. We store all images you send securely, and they won't be shown to anyone unless there is a need. For example, we would show them to photographers who are looking for models for Filament shoots.

When you email photographs, please also tell us:

- your approximate location (ie, country and city)
- your age
- · what level of explicitness you're happy with.

# So you like the look of me, then what?

In most cases, if we think your look would go down well is something we need right now *and* we work with a photographer in your area, we'd pass your photos on to him or her to arrange a shoot. If we don't have a photographer in your area, or if you'd prefer to work with a photographer you know, simply come up with a shoot idea together, shoot it and send us the pictures!

We look forward to receiving your pictures.
